The Jeeva Vikas Society has been instrumental in creating positive change in the Wardha district by focusing on critical areas such as disabilities, women's empowerment, HIV, community health, and family support. Their commitment to serving rural and underserved populations has established a solid foundation of trust and collaboration within local communities, enabling them to address unique challenges effectively.

Through a variety of targeted interventions, Jeeva Vikas Society has successfully met the diverse needs of individuals with disabilities, impoverished women, and children affected by HIV. By embracing innovative solutions and fostering collaborative partnerships, the organization has demonstrated that sustainable change is possible, even in the face of adversity.

The impact of their work extends beyond immediate assistance, as they cultivate resilience and encourage communities to adopt inclusive practices in health and social support. By advocating for the rights and well-being of marginalized groups, Jeeva Vikas Society paves the way for a more equitable future, fostering an environment where every individual has the opportunity to thrive and contribute to society. Their holistic approach not only transforms lives but also inspires other organizations and stakeholders to adopt similar strategies aimed at empowerment and inclusivity.

The year 2024-25 ensured the continuation of all the activities initiated in previous year with some additional self-sponsoring activities that are recurring in nature. The activities have contributed a lot in maintaining the pace of the initiatives that were made during the previous year, thereby making a meaning of the interventions. The prominent activities include the Palliative care (Newly started) , rehabilitation of disabled persons, community health, women empowerment and intervention with Children affected and infected with HIV/AIDs. Similarly, the awareness programmes, activation of Self-help Groups, sensitization programmes and support to poor have maintained its pace in the year. Some efforts on resource mobilization were also made. The self-sponsored programmes are mostly philanthropic in nature and some sensitization activities. The staff and associates of the organization should also get due credit for sustaining their interest and showing commitment in organizational efforts.

Jeevan Vikas Society has identified some areas for future that includes strengthening resource mobilization efforts, partnering with government departments and CSR units as well as looking for Anemia and malnourishment initiatives in future, other than the regular activities.

OBJECTIVES FOR THE YEAR

The following are the objectives of the year other than the fixed objectives

- To work for the development of Adolescent girls , women and child development
- To strengthen the Disabled Persons Organization and empower them economically
- To improve the health-conscious behavior of people through community health programmes.
- To initiate Geriatric and Palliative care in the rural areas.
- To conduct sensitization programmes on various themes as well as to make interventions on malnourishment amongst women and children and Anemia.
- To explore possible partnership with Government departments and CSR units
- To continue the livelihood strengthening programme and the community-based rehabilitation of persons with special needs
- To coordinate with other agencies working for the welfare & development of rural societies.

These groups are officially registered under the Maharashtra State Rural Livelihood Mission (MSRLM), which provides a structured platform for rural development and livelihood enhancement.

Early intervention can significantly improve the quality of life for individuals with disabilities through timely diagnosis and appropriate treatment, which may include therapies, educational support, and rehabilitation services.

INCOME GENERATING ACTIVITIES FOR DISABLED

Success story

The story of Anil Khose, a disabled man facing significant financial struggles, along with the support he's receiving from various organizations like the Jeevan Vikas Society and CBR workers. Anil Khose, who became blind due to a medical error, is working hard with his wife and children to make ends meet. Despite his challenging circumstances, he has received support from the Gram Panchayat through the Gharkul Yojana, allowing him to build a house. His wife works as a daily laborer to support the family.

The CBR (Community-Based Rehabilitation) worker is actively involved in helping Anil and his family by providing guidance, helping with financial management (such as opening savings accounts), and ensuring that the family's business venture, which is vital for their survival, remains sustainable. Through the Jeevan Vikas Society, Anil received the necessary tools to open a small shop, which he hopes will help support his family and educate his children.

It's a difficult situation, but with the support of Manos Unidas and Jeevan vikas these organizations and the guidance of the CBR worker, Anil Khose is determined to improve his family's financial situation. By the support of Manos unidas organization Harsh started a shoes shop. He started to earn the livelihood. He and his family are grateful to the organization.

The tangible benefits provided to beneficiaries through various livelihood activities. By offering essential resources like goats, stationery, groceries, and clothes, along with crucial training, disabled are significantly enhancing their income potential and quality of life.

2. **Women Empowerment programme of MANOS:** With the support of Manos, the organization is implementing a special women empowerment programme at 20 villages of Wardha district covering more than 500 women. The programme aims at formation of women self-help groups, capacitating them to manage the SHG as well as to undertake business, facilitating the marketing arrangements, supporting individual poor women members in starting entrepreneurship. The support to them include providing Goats, initial funds to purchase the first-time raw materials, etc, facilitating the business process. Disabled persons are given top priority for supporting of starting entrepreneurs. The project is being implemented in a different way where there is focus on ensuring marketing of the products. Further the groups are being used only to market and ensure a fixed catchment area, and individual women members will be doing their business separately. Other members will help them only to market the products. This will ensure taking up more type of vocational trading in every group and it will improve the economic situation of the groups thereby addressing the issues of conventional cohesiveness of the group members. This year, the organization has touched another 300 ultra-poor women during the year.
3. **Community Health Programme:** Community health has been a flagship programme of the organization and is being taken up in at least 30 underserved villages of Wardha at any point of time. Now the organization is being supported by Hilton Foundation and Catholic Health Association of India. This programme basically ensures general health care services to the people and capacitates the communities for claiming health care services at different available sources. It is a programme of both demand

generation and service delivery at communities. The programme also fosters health volunteers at community level. These volunteers are becoming the resource persons to the communities. Till date more than 50 such volunteers were developed in 30 villages and more than 20,000 people were approached for health care counselling during the year in these 30 villages.

4. **Palliative Care**: This is a new programme the organization has initiated during the year with the support of Hilton foundation and Catholic Health Association of India. This is a programme aimed at ensuring joyful transition for persons suffering from life threatening diseases. The programme is also supported by the Faith practices. The organization is dealing with more than 20 such persons and forming respite groups. It is trying to introduce the home-based care for palliative care in future.
5. **Intervention on Children Affected and infected with AIDs**: This is another new programme initiated by the organization with the support of Catholic Health Association of India at Wardha district at the selected underserved 30 villages. The project is now handling more than 75 such target children who are being rehabilitated and imparted health and education services along with fooding and clothing facilities.

6. **Strengthening Self-help Groups**: Empowering women starts from within. Regular meeting of women forming social capital is the key to empowering women in all spheres. This is a periodical program conducted by the organization. Under this programme, it attempts to activate the dormant SHGs and forming new SHGs. The SHGs are imparted training on the management of the SHG, leadership trainings as well as on various vocational trainings. The programme is partly supported by some donors and a part are self-sponsored. The volunteers of the organization are concurrently guiding and supporting the groups and the women are enjoying the association with the Organization. Around 50 women Self Help Groups are being intervened in 20 villages of Wardha district covering around 500 women under this programme. It is a continuation of the previous year programme.

SELF-HELP GROUP TRAINING

The Jeevan Vikas Society is embarking on a comprehensive initiative to conduct training sessions on self-help groups (SHGs) across 20 villages in Wardha. This project aims to empower women, foster community development, and promote economic independence through collective action and support.

- **Empowerment of Women:** To equip women with the knowledge and skills to form and manage SHGs, enhancing their leadership capabilities and decision-making power within their communities.
- **Financial Literacy:** To provide training on savings, credit management, and financial planning to enable women to manage their finances effectively.
- **Vocational Skills:** To introduce vocational training modules that align with local market demands, helping women acquire skills necessary for employment or entrepreneurship.
- **Product Marketing:** To educate participants on effective marketing strategies for selling products created by SHG members, thereby improving their income-generating potential.
- **Networking Opportunities:** To create a platform for women to connect, share experiences, and support each other in their entrepreneurial endeavours.



Empowering Women Through Tailoring Classes in Wardha

In an empowering initiative across eight villages in Wardha, tailoring classes have been introduced to provide vocational training for underprivileged women. Each batch consists of 15-20 participants, enabling focused learning and personalized attention.

- Increased earning potential for participants, leading to improved financial stability.
- Enhanced self-esteem and confidence among women as they acquire new skills.
- Strengthening of community ties through shared learning and empowerment.

This training program can be a transformative experience for women in the Wardha area, providing them with valuable skills to improve their economic conditions. By focusing on culinary activities like making pickles, masalas, and papads, we can empower women to create sustainable businesses while celebrating and promoting their local culture.

Training on Gotay and Poultry farming

A specialized training session on poultry and goat farming was conducted for poor women in Wardha, organized by Jeevan Vikas Society. The training aimed to empower women with the skills and knowledge necessary to improve their livelihoods through sustainable farming practices.

During the session, expert trainers provided comprehensive insights into the fundamentals of poultry rearing and goat farming. Topics covered included:

Poultry Farming:

- Understanding different poultry breeds and their maintenance.
- Marketing strategies for poultry products.

Goat Farming:

- Selection of suitable goat breeds for local conditions.
- Basic care and management practices.



7. **Awareness programmes:** The organization has been conducting various awareness and sensitization programmes on many themes with self-sponsored mode. The activities are being undertaken either in cooperation or in support of other NGOS and related agencies. This year the organization has conducted sensitizing events on subjects such as health awareness, sanitation, disabled persons schemes, Reproductive rights and social welfare schemes provisioned by the government and on health & hygiene. The events were in the form of community meetings, village level interface. The programmes were supported by the Panchayats and there was huge demand for organizing these events on a periodical mode, in total 47 such events were organized at the villages of Wardha districts. The most important factor of these programme is the complete contribution of PRI and other volunteers. The organization has leveraged good resources for these programmes. The subjects on which the awareness programmes were conducted are listed as follows



- Awareness on health-conscious behavior and fostering alternative medicine systems
- Awareness on HIV/AIDS and sickle cell anemia
- Awareness on communicable diseases such as Malaria, Tb, Typhoid, hepatitis, filaria etc.
- Awareness on malnourishment and anemia
- Awareness on De-addiction
- Awareness on various governmental social security programmes





8. **Health activities:** Every year Jeevan Vikas Society is undertaking various types of health-related activities with self-sponsored mode and leveraging the available resources needed for the activities. The external donations, support of other NGOs and community support are prominent amongst the support it receives. The activities under Health programme include organizing health camps, support to poor patients by referring to the governmental facilities and ensuring medicines etc., interventions with adolescent health by undertaking life skill education and sanitation education, menstrual hygiene programmes at communities and schools, reproductive child health programmes, interventions for malnourishment and anemia and sensitization on health issues etc. A brief detail of the health-related programmes are as follows: -



- **Health Screening Camps:** The organization has organized seven such health camps at the villages of Wardha under community health and disability rehabilitation programmes. The camps basically aim at general ailments and RCH services. The average patient turnout per camp emerged at 100-120 patients. The camps were conducted with the help of local governance and associated agencies. Jeevan Vikas Society makes all necessary arrangements of logistics at the venue before the camp.

- **Nutrition Support:** Through the programmes, Jeevan Vikas Society is providing nutritional support to poor malnourished children, poor women and adolescents. They are identified properly and supported. During the year more than 350 such persons have benefited with this support.



- **Reproductive and Child health:** This is also a recurring programme of Jeevan Vikas Society. Under this programme it tracks the poor pregnant women at villages as well as from rural areas covered by the organization. By tracking it ensures complete ANC, Institutional delivery, and PNC. It also tracks the children who misses the routine immunization. The activity is being conducted with the help of organizational volunteers and with the technical support of specialized persons. Lot of help was received from the government health facilities and department also. The organization has also conducted many sessions with adolescent girls on menstrual hygiene and Anemia.

9. **Income Generation activities:** This is a periodical programme through the projects encouraging the rural women to take up small income generating activities. This year the trades through which income generation was planned include development of home gardens and cultivation of vegetables in rural households, cultivation of mushrooms, goatary, retail business etc. The activities were taken up by engaging the trainer of the specific trade. Similarly, it also trains women on relevant trades that can fetch some income for them. More than 300 women were trained on income generating activities and around 180 have started their self-employment

entrepreneurship business. Some of the women who were trained on tailoring are stitching and selling school uniforms to children. Through other projects also some of them are getting initial support for starting their entrepreneurship.



10. **Support to Poor** : This is a recurring programme of the organization, which aimed at supporting the poor with materials and financial support. The support extended includes blankets, rain coats, books and copies, educational fees to poor children, aids and appliances etc. This year more than 250 persons were supported.





11. **Celebrations:** Jeevan Vikas society is celebrating many functions every year with an aim to enthuse cultural strengthening, fostering inclusive culture and motivating people for social harmony. The regular celebrations it has conducted during the year includes Independence Day, Republic Day, World Disability Day, world Diabetes Day and World Health Day Diwali, Holi, Makar Sankranti, Christmas etc. Most of the celebrations are planned at the villages and attempts are made to involve as many people as possible.
